

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Prior to anticipated date of move-in/out, furniture delivery or pick-ups, vendor is required to provide us with evidence of valid "Certificate of Insurance" conforming the building's requirements. Certificate must be received by Management Office 24-48 Business hours prior to scheduled delivery/pick-up date to avoid delays in building access and/or use of elevator.

WORKER'S COMPENSATION/GENERAL LIABILITY/AUTOMOBILE LIABILITY

Mandatory and is required on all COI's

MINIMUM COVERAGE:

\$1,000,000.00 minimum coverage amount is required on all Certificate of Insurances.

ENDORSEMENT PAGE

For each policy in the lower right portion on the standard ACCORD form, the notification box is to be checked and the words "endeavor" crossed out.

CANCELLATION:

Should any of the above-described policies be canceled prior to the expiration date thereof, the issuing insurer must advise of such by mailing written notice to the certificate holder, owner and fee Manager, at least 30 days prior to cancellation.

FURNITURE MEASURING GUIDE

Below, please find the measurements of the Service Elevator.

- Door Opening 36 Inches
- Height 120 Inches
- Width 70.6 Inches
- Depth 42.3 Inches

Note:

More important than the elevator measurement, is the height of the corridors:

THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT:

You must measure your furniture on the diagonal, in order to assure that it will dear the ceiling in the corridors.

In other words, measure your furniture form the top left corner to the bottom right-hand corner, at the portion of the furniture which is at its widest perimeter.

The total diagonal length of your furniture must not exceed 94 inches
